

Annual Report of Academic Session 2021 - 22

After the panic of covid-19 was brought under control, a government order was received to start classes in actual attendance and after passing of two years, the presence of students in the college was seen again, this is the unique feature of this academic year. According to the academic schedule published by Gondwana University from August 30, 2021 various academic and extra-curricular activities were carried out in two academic sessions upto 30th June, 2022. The academic year started with the admission process after the results of class XII. The students filled the admission form by visiting the website of the college. The admission of the students was finalized as per the recommendation of the admission committee. In the session 2021-22, 5561 students were admitted in undergraduate and postgraduate classes out of which 60% are girls and the number of students from rural areas is high and 78% students are from backward classes.

In this session, After the retirement of Principal Dr. R.P. Ingole, the Dr P.M Katkar took over as Principal on 1st September 2021. Since January 2022 is the last date for the accreditation of the college by the NAAC, all preparations have been made to conduct the fourth accreditation by the NAAC through the Steering Committee throughout the year. The proposal was submitted to NAAC in January 2022. SSR was submitted on March 30, and the SSS and DVV process was completed in May 2022. A visit of the peer team of NAAC is proposed in the coming academic session. The college has achieved ISO certification in this session.

In the summer 2021 examination results were announced by Gondwana University Gadchiroli, 62 students of the college got placed in the merit list and 3 students were awarded gold medals. Second degree distribution Ceremony as per New Maharashtra University Act done on 28th December, 2021. Dr. Prashant Bokare, Vice Chancellor, Gondwana University guided the students and they were accorded due hospitality. On this occasion a booklet showing the information of meritorious students was published.

In the college, as per the suggestion of the government, Career Katta was started and in our first participation we received the state government consolation award. College student Ku. Neha Samanpaliwar was declared the best student of Gondwana University. It was presented to her on October 2, 2021, the anniversary day of Gondwana University.

Dr. Kuldeep Gond was honored with the Sanjeevani Foundation's Outstanding Work Award. From Marathi department Dr. Vidyadhar Bansod and Dr. Padmarekha Dhankar was honored with the prestigious award in the field of literature.

After a break of two sessions in the field of sports, the students achieved spectacular success. At the beginning of the session, the Sports Department successfully organized an international webinar on Holistic Approach of Science & Yoga during the 21st Century. During the two-day event, Mrs. Natalia Solve of Argentina, Mr. Vijay Singh Chouhan, Piyush Jain, Vice Chancellor Srinivasa Varkhedi, Dr. Karwande, Dr. Kishor, Dr. Laxmikant Rathod was the resource persons. National Sports Day was celebrated by the Sports Department. The students were honored for their outstanding performance. 35 students of the college received colour coats, 80 students participated in the All India competition. Once again we have received the highest number of winning titles at Gondwana University gadchiroli. The college won the general championship. Free summer sports training camp was organized by the sports department.

Various activities were organized by the Cultural Department during the year. A tribute meeting was organized after the death of Gansamradnyi Late Lata Mangeshkar. A singing competition was organized in her memory. 23 students took part in this memorable competition. A dance competition was organized by the Cultural Department in which 30 students participated. Song competitions, poster competitions, essay writing competitions, slogan competitions etc. were organized by our colleges. In this competition, Ku. Kajal Das, Ku.vrushali Bhujade, Ku Prachi Joshi, Ku. Vaishnavi Raut received the award. An inter-college general knowledge competition was organized in collaboration with Sanjeevani Foundation.

A webinar of Dr. Jayashree Kapase, a senior actor, was taken on the topic “Diwas tumche Fulayche” in January 2022.

Many educational and extra curricular activities were carried out by various departments of the college. In July 2021, the Department of Computer Studies and Research organized a three day Faculty Development Program on Data Analytics Using Excel. A three-day program on FDP, Introduce Yourself & Know Your PC was organized on the topic of basic research principles for research professors /students, Gondwana University has developed a new system for sending marks under digitization from this year. A workshop was organized in January 2022 to explain the whole method, Seminar on Data Structure was organized. A week long student development program on Ms-access was organized. Mrs. Vinanti Kesarkar of Hindustan Petroleum conducted webinar on cleanliness as mission for the students. Mr. Rahul Kundu, an international expert, was given 21 days training and guidance to the students preparing for MCA admission. Dr. Pradosh Patnaik and Dr. Ajay Kushwaha hosted a national level webinar on IPR and Patent Filing. For the students to be able to master the English language, Dr. Swapnil Bhagat’s one month course on Spoken English Classes and Personality Development was conducted. Personality development through ICT, Working with SQL etc. seminars were organized. Computer Club organized Poster Competition, Blind Coding and Elocation Competition. Guidance of Adv.Farhat Beg’s on Minority Rights Day was

organized. Workshop on writing of research synopsis, cyber security etc. was carried out by Dr.Prashant Arve, Dr.Nitin Janwe. Smt. Priyadarshini Shanmugam's webinar on "Indian Patent Exam Registration Process" was organized in December 2021.NASCOM Foundation Hyderabad conducted a three day workshop on 'Data Science'. Mr. Raghuraj Singh and NASCOM Project Manager Shri. Murlidhar Nara guided the students. Lectures on Data Structure were organized for the students. IIT Mumbai sponsored IIT Spoken Tutorial exam was conducted. On 8th April, 2022, the students of the Computer Science Department visited Ballarpur Paper Industry and got acquainted with the working system there.

The Alumni Association of the college is active and through them many useful, social activities were implemented for the students. On the subject of "India needs Gandhiji" "University Level Poster Competition was organized. Out of 23 posters received, the best five posters were given cash prizes and certificates. With the aim of fulfilling social responsibility, health diagnosis camp and free medicine were distributed in the adopted village Aravat under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan in collaboration with IMA. For this, Dr. Mundhada cooperated. Dr. Shrikant Joshi, Dr. Vilas Mulay explained the importance of organ donation. Wheelchairs were provided to Ballarpur Railway Station for relocation of the disabled through Alumni Association and Lions Club Mahakali. In this session, the election of the alumni association was held and the new executive body was announced. Through this committee, parents meeting was held and a Parent Association was formed. On behalf of the Department of Mathematics, Dr. Pradip Kumar Joshi conducted the workshop on Numerical Method. Also Pai (11) Day was celebrated.

Many student oriented activities through Career guidance and competitive examination cell were organized. Mr. Nitesh Devgade, Forest Officer, Allapalli inaugurated and conducted Banking classes were conducted on 11th October, 224 students benefited from this banking class. Senior Scientist Dr. Kiran Bhagat from ICMR Pune gave guest lectures on the subject Job oppurtunities after undergraduate and postgraduate education. He. Income. In collaboration with I.F.A.S.Pune ,11 webinar on NET, SET JAM for different students were organized on the same day, In this Omkar Girkar, Pradyumna Dixit, Siddharth Das, Devdutt Sharma, Prajakta Chowgule guided the students. Career Katta, ambitious project of the Department of Higher Education was started in the college.

The inauguration of the Department of Microbiology Student Club was held on 18th October. Dr.A.M.Deshmukh inaugurated this club. On this occasion, Dr.S.D. Patankar's lecture was organized. A one-day National Conference was organized on 25th November with the collaboration of Thakur College, Mumbai. National Science Day was celebrated on 28th February through various activities. The students of the department visited the ICMR center and also went to City Madhyamik Vidyalaya Babupeth and guided the students. A health related activity 'Sickle Cell Detection Camp'

was organized by the Department of Zoology on 13th December. Assisted by the staff of Sickle Cell Department, Government of Maharashtra. With the collaboration of Eco-Pro on the occasion of Wildlife Week, Dr. Ravikant Khobragade, Shri. Bandu Dhotre and Dr. R. W. Kamble guided the students. The Student Club Zoology Society was inaugurated on this occasion. The students visited the Pyar Foundation to work in the field of animal rescue and got to know the work there.

The postgraduate students of the Department of Chemistry visited the Manikgad Cement industry under the Women Empowerment initiative and understood the working method. Dr. Panda, Dr. Sharma guided the girls. Dr. Avneet Kumar Joshi, Director, CIPET, gave a talk on “Plastic” and inaugurated the Chemical Society. Dr. Dhabekar from Nagpur conducted a webinar on makeup and styling for the students of the fashion department of the college.

The students of NSS have voluntarily donated Rs.21000/ & provided financial assistance and assisted in health diagnosis and distribution of medicines at Aravat. The Heritage Walk is run by Eco-pro. The walk is organized from the fort of Chandrapur. The fort was cleaned with the participation of NSS students. NSS and other students participated in the Zoom Meeting on 8th February 2022 organized by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India under the theme 'आजादी का अमृत महोत्सव' On the occasion of Mahatma Jyotiba Phule's birthday, Dr. T. D. Kose gave the lecture, which sheds light on biography, was jointly organized by the Department of Sociology and NSS. On the occasion of Shivswarajya coronation day which was on 6th June, Dr. Vidyadhar Bansod's lecture was organized. Health Committee and NSS Unit and Vimaladevi Ayurvedic College jointly organized health guidance and health check-up camp on October 21, 2021. The Department of Sociology visited the old age home at Debusavali and distributed fruits and biscuits. The college celebrates various national days, and anniversaries of great personalities. Independence Day, Republic Day, Maharashtra Day, Constitution Day, Yogadivas, Shivswarajya Foundation Day, Environment Day, Women's Day etc. The days are celebrated with appropriate activities.

On behalf of the Department of Home Economics, the Vice

Chancellor , Dr. Srinivas Varkhedi inaugurated the Nutrition Week. Dr. Nagina Kolhe and Dr. Pallavi Ingle guided at this occasion. Healthy Boys and Girls Competition Program was organized by the Department of Home Economics. On behalf of BSM and the college, the Vice Chancellor of Gondwana University, Dr. Prashant Bokare delivered a lecture on the life of Dharmपाल. Dr. Satyapal Meshram has explained the situation of education in India before British came to India.

The college has research centers in 18 subjects and 32 guides. 68 students are doing research and 14 students have got Ph.D. degree in this year. While carrying out social, educational, student-oriented activities, the college professor published research articles in several reputed journals.
