## 1.0 Sardar Patel Mahavidyalaya, Chandrapur

### 1.1 Profile

Sardar Patel Mahavidyalaya was established in 1970 with an aim to provide quality education to students from rural and backward region of Chandrapur district, Maharashtra. The college offers number of basic and professional programmes from undergraduate to research level in Arts, Commerce, Science and other faculties. All the programmes are directed towards realization of our Vision and Mission and achieving our objectives in keeping with the values set by *Sarvodaya Shikshan Mandal*. Around 5500 students are enrolled under all courses excluding junior college with 49 university approved faculty members. Among enrolled students 67% students are girls and about 78% students belongs to socially and economically backward class. *Sarvodaya Shikshan Mandal* was awarded with **Best Management** award by Government of Maharashtra.

The college was assessed and accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore in March 2004 and awarded with 'B<sup>++</sup>' Grade. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was established on the recommendations of the Peer Team for enhancing the quality of academics in the college on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2010. The college was assessed and accredited for its second cycle by NAAC and awarded 'B' Grade with **2.85** CGPA on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2011. After second cycle by NAAC, affiliation of college is changed from RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur to Gondwana University, Gadchiroli.

The members of *Sarvodaya Shikshan Mandal's*, Sardar Patel Mahavidyalaya, have been in search of excellence in various fields of life. Under the dynamic leadership of Hon'ble Shri Shantaramji Potdukhe, Ex. Union Minister of State for Finance and all the members of *Sarvodaya Shikshan Mandal*, Chandrapur the college has emerged as a premier institute of higher learning of education and research in eastern Vidarbha. The joint efforts of teaching and non teaching staff members have contributed to this achievement.

As a mark of excellence the college conducts academic, cultural, sports and other regional, state and national level meets. The college research magazine SPM Journal of Academic Research (SPM JAR) is now reputed journal among academicians and SPM Students Research Magazine is also highly acclaimed magazine for promotion of research aptitude among students and research scholar.



Though they are highly appreciated, however, some more efforts need to be taken for original and qualitative research work and publication.

The college has established latest English Laboratory for students for effective English communication as per recommendation of PTR with a capacity of 20 students. Maintaining the daily teaching report in Daily Diary is a practice to record annual and daily teaching for efficient teaching. Apart from regular teaching, the college runs UGC sponsored short term courses like Fashion Designing, Travel & Tourism and Maintenance of Home Appliances as an additional qualification which will be very useful for seeking employment. There are seven well equipped computer laboratories and 300 computers with latest software installed and latest NMEICT broadband facility with 10 mbps speed is also available and the college is connected for internet communication. An electronic interactive Smart Board is installed at Late Shri Shalikgram Gawalpanchi Hall.

During academic session 2014-15, 35 students were placed in merit list declared by Gondwana University, Gadchiroli and 13 students of college were awarded with Gold Medal in university convocation. In last academic session 50 students were placed in merit list of university and two were awarded with Gold Medal. Many students participated in cultural event of university level “*Indradhanushya*” and won prizes for college. Student represented university in many sports events and college honored with “General Championship” by Gondwana University, Gadchiroli. Students brought laurels by participating and winning prizes in University level Research Convention “*Avishkar*”. College has organized banking examination classes which were conducted by Alumni of this college. TCS conducted employability readiness training. Some students participated in skill development program.

The college has a central library with richest collection of books over 75,729, internet facility, reading room, library software LIBMAN and subscribed to N-LIST. For promoting intellectual development of students, efforts were made to encourage them to participate in group discussions, paper presentations, wall paper and model competitions, art gallery, writing in college magazine “*Shabdagandha*” which is awarded with best magazine by university consecutively for three years, conferences, seminars etc.

The Centre for Higher Learning and Research in Arts, Commerce and Science faculty is one of the centers in Gondwana University which is providing research



facility in twelve subjects. Number of outside research scholars has enrolled at this centre for their research work. Fourteen Minor Research Projects (MRP) sponsored by UGC have been completed by faculty members and had submitted another 28 proposals to UGC for financial assistance. Recently one Major Research Project in Microbiology Department was sanctioned by UGC.

College take special care in organizing health related programs especially about prevailing diseases, awareness and counseling programs concerning girl students. Efforts were also made to curb eve teasers, ragging, addiction, smoking etc. The college has a girl's hostel facility within the campus and provides lodging and boarding facility to 115 students.

The college had organized university level NSS camp during previous academic session and now planning to organize a state level camp during this academic session. Visapur village is adopted for its development under NSS programme and numbers of activities were carried out for its overall development.

The college has a placement cell to provide employment opportunity to students. Number of reputed companies had recruited the students in their organizations. Students are placed in company's viz. Wipro, Infosys, TCS and other insurance, finance companies.

The college is the only college in Gondwana University to setup and run Blood Collection Centre and blood is being regularly collected and supplied to Government District Hospital, Chandrapur. As district has large population of sickle cell affected individual, regular checkup camps are held at college. An extension counter of Shri Kanyaka Nagari Sahakari Bank in the college campus facilitates the students and teachers. A Co-operative Store provides basic amenities to the students such as practical record and assignment copies. The college responded to appeal made by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and started Clean India Mission.

We believe that cumulative efforts, hard work and dedication will surely lead us to our goal. We are looking forward to receive good rank in NAAC accreditation.

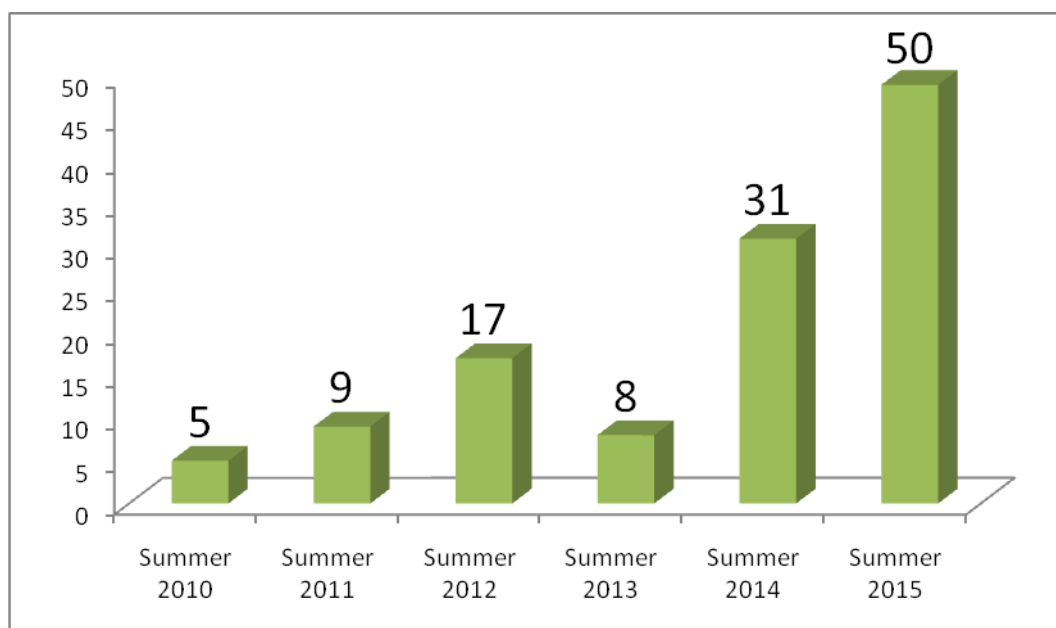
